## Scholarship - Returning Families

### TUITION 2026-2027

Kindergarten – Grade 5	\$10,080
Grade 6 – Grade 12	\$9,350

\* UA -Special accommodation fees  
REQUIRED and range from \$1,500 - \$4,500

A non-refundable Registration Amount of \$100.00 is due upon acceptance of re-enrollment.

Reenrollment is perpetual by meeting the enrollment standards and is based on receipt of the deposit assessed. *You will be responsible for the difference between the scholarship payment and the tuition/fees assessed.*

Spaces will only be held for those who have paid the full deposit and for those who are CURRENT in their tuition account (do not owe past balances). The deposit is non-refundable.

Select from two payment options:

**Plan A** Pay in full by September 1st (avoids the \$315.00 payment plan convenience fee).

**Plan B.** Nine (9) monthly payments due on or before August and last payment by April 1. \$315.00 convenience fee added to tuition to activate the plan.

*Payments are due the 1st of the month with late fees of \$35 assessed after the 5th day of each month. **LATE FEES WILL NOT BE WAIVED AT ANY TIME.***

### MATRICULATION FEE \$350.00

**DUE by May 1st to secure space for**

**August.** These fees include books, a field trip (25.00), a yearbook, and technology.

**We encourage families to start making payments in February once registration is confirmed to ensure payment is timely to secure your child's space.**

### AFTER CARE PROGRAM

Monthly payment \$ 200.00  
Paid at the **beginning** of the month prior to the 5th, otherwise your child will not be eligible for care on the next business day.

Drop-in per Day  
\$ 20.00 - 3 pm to 5:30 pm  
\$ 10.00 per day 3 pm to 4 pm  
A deposit of \$150 is due up front if you wish to be considered for "drop-in / per day" options.

**Prompt pick-up is very important in this program.** *Following the first instance, a late fee of **\$5.00 per minute** will be charged if a child is at school after 5:30 p.m. and is payable at the time of pick up; otherwise, your child will not be able to attend the following day.*

### CAPITAL CAMPAIGN /ANNUAL GIVING

As tuition covers only 80% of the actual cost of educating each child, supplementary fundraising is crucial to the health of the school. **All families are asked – and expected – to support the school's CAPITAL CAMPAIGNS to the best of their ability.** Your help is essential. A non-refundable **Registration Amount of \$500.00** is due upon acceptance of the **NEW Contract**. This fee is not applied to any tuition or materials fee balance.

Spaces will only be held for those who have paid the full deposit and for those who are **CURRENT** in their tuition account (**do not owe past balances**). The deposit is non-refundable. *You will be responsible for the difference between the scholarship payment and tuition assessed.*

Select from two payment options:

**Plan A** Pay in full by September 1st (*avoids the \$315.00 payment plan convenience fee*).

**Plan B.** Nine (9) monthly payments due on or before August and last payment by April 1. *\$315.00 convenience fee added to tuition to activate the plan.*
